COMPETITOR BULLETIN - ROUND 12 TYRE ALLOCATION

Dear Competitor/Entrant,

This formal bulletin is to alert you to an adjustment to both UAE RMC Technical Regulations 2014-15 Article 2 and UAE RMC Sporting Regulations 2014-15 Article 4.1.2, concerning the quantity of tyres permitted.

The below ruling will form part of the event Supplementary Regulations for Round 12 only and supersede the aforementioned Articles, applicable to all categories.

For Round 12 only (from non-qualifying practice to the end of the Final), the maximum number of slick tyres, new or used, permitted is 2 complete sets (4 front, 4 rear).

For clarification, competitors may choose from the following possible combinations and declare this at Scrutineering (subject to Articles 2.4.5.2 and 4.1 of the UAE RMC Sporting Regulations 2014-15):

- 1. ONE USED SET OF TYRES
- 2. ONE NEW SET OF TYRES
- 3. ONE NEW SET AND ONE USED SET OF TYRES
- 4. TWO USED SETS OF TYRES
- 5. TWO NEW SETS OF TYRES

Options 3, 4 and 5 represent the <u>maximum</u> allocation to cover both event days including practice on Day 1 and warm-up on Day 2.

For competitors selecting option 1 or 2, additional sets will be subject to availability and according to Article 2.4.5.2 of the UAE RMC Sporting Regulations 2014-15.

It is understood that some competitors have already completed the entry formalities for Round 12 including payment. Any such ones wishing to increase their allocation of tyres for Round 12 should send a mail to gina@alainraceway.com BEFORE the Entry deadline on Friday 27th March. To avoid unnecessary inconvenience, any additional payment can be arranged by 10th April (still at the preferential price) but it is essential that we know your requirement in advance so that we can prepare all equipment.

It should be noted that a second set of tyres is OPTIONAL, not mandatory. The supplementary increase is to make adequate provision for the relatively high number of laps scheduled over the two race days. Some competitors will be able to get through both days on one set of tyres without issue. Some will not.
